## *Who is a Creative Teacher?*



*A creative teacher is one who:*

- ✓ *Recognizes and respects the creative potential of each child.*
- ✓ *Has a humanist view of creativity vs. the genius view of creativity.*
- ✓ *Is self-aware, conscious and deliberate rather than habit driven.*
- ✓ *Has the ability to make the complex appear simple.*
- ✓ *Communicates in a manner accessible and comprehensible to the learner.*
- ✓ *Maps ideas on learners' experiences to convey concepts.*
- ✓ *Motivates learners to widen their zone of proximal development.*
- ✓ *Is never complacent about him/herself or his/her learners.*
- ✓ *Is sure of his/her own concepts.*
- ✓ *Is spontaneous and responsive to classroom challenges.*
- ✓ *Is willing to veer away from lesson plans if the situation so demands.*
- ✓ *Empower learners by encouraging self-directed learning.*
- ✓ *Understands 'why' a certain topic has been included in the syllabus.*
- ✓ *Focuses on 'how' rather than 'what' to teach but recognizes the latter is also important.*
- ✓ *Interprets the textbook and curriculum creatively and steps beyond their confines*
- ✓ *Is willing to engage standards / norms and accepts the same from learners.*

## The PGDCT - Course outline

As part of the course, a student would have to take 7 papers. Of these 6 are compulsory papers and one is an optional paper, which is the Pedagogy paper. Students can opt one among six different Pedagogy papers.

- ❖ Each paper is divided into three blocks and each block has four units.
- ❖ Each paper would thus contain 12 units. The entire course of 7 papers would include 84 units.
- ❖ Details of the Syllabus are provided along with the Self Instructional Material (SIM)

## Self Instructional Material (SIM)

The Course wise comprehensive Self Instructional Material (SIM) will be supplied to the students admitted. The students would have the option to collect it from JACT, Bangalore personally or receive it by post.

The Study material is interactive and permits the students to engage with the concepts and topics under discussion without requiring a 'face to face interaction' with the subject experts. While designing the material, the needs of a distance learner have been taken into account. ## Assignments and School Practicum:



In Each paper the student would be required to submit a minimum of three assignments – one from each block. Of these, the two best would be included for the purposes of evaluation. The assignments should be neatly hand written or keyed in on A4 size paper. ***Name of the student, paper code and title, block number and date*** should be clearly mentioned at the start of assignment. Assignments can also be e-mailed to [iact-ksou@jaingroup.info](mailto:iact-ksou@jaingroup.info) The schedule for submission of assignments is enclosed at the end.

During the course the student will have to complete a project, which is a part of the school practicum, linked to pedagogy. For the purpose of School Practicum you need to identify a senior teacher in a school. If you are an in-service candidate you could identify a senior teacher of the same pedagogy and if you are not an in-service candidate JACT would identify a teacher from amongst the associate schools. He/She will be the mentor teacher and will have to observe your classes (at least five classes or one unit) for the purpose of assessing your teaching skills based on the criteria provided by us.

The content of the School Practicum are:

- Comprehensive lesson plan for the 5 classes
- Identification of special teaching aids used in the class
- Unit test constructed for a unit with the blue print and model answers for the same unit.
- Once the same is administered in the school, the results to be evaluated with graphical interpretation.

After the completion of the practical sessions you need to send us the unit plan, unit test plan with answers, graphical interpretation of test, a write-up on the teaching aids.

This project will be evaluated from the perspective of each of the other papers also.

## Evaluation System:

The Evaluation system would be based on Grades.

There would be 60 % weightage for the Course end examination and 40% weightage for Internal Assessment. The 40% weightage for Internal Assessment would be on the basis of

Assignments – 30%

Projects - 10%

In Paper 7 (Pedagogy) the project would be the Practice Teaching in a School selected by the student but approved by 7ACT .

A grade of **D** and above must be obtained in each paper. An **E** grade in any of the papers would require repetition of the course for successful completion of the Degree.

In each semester a grade point average will be computed in which the student must achieve a **Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) of 2 or above**. A final overall grade, at the end of two semesters will be computed on the basis of a Cumulative Grade Point Average (C.G.P.A).
